



ITINERARY

DAY 01

ARRIVAL IN CAPE TOWN

Upon arrival in Capetown, your transfer will wait for you at the arrivals area to take you to **The Silo Hotel**.

The SILO HOTEL (4 NIGHTS)



The Silo Hotel sets a new standard for luxury Cape Town accommodation. A magical hotel towering above the V&A Waterfront surrounded by the natural wonder of South Africa's Mother City.

The Silo Hotel has been built in the grain elevator portion of the historic grain silo complex occupying six floors above Zeitz Museum of Contemporary Art Africa (MOCAA) which houses Africa's largest collection of contemporary African art.

The exterior of the building was designed by Heatherwick Studio. From the outside, the greatest visible change to the building's original structure is the addition of the ingenious glass windows inserted into the geometry of the hotel floors. These multi-faceted structures glisten like diamonds during the day while at night the building transforms into a glowing beacon in the Table Bay harbour.

DAY 2

HALF DAY CAPE TOWN CITY AND TABLE MOUNTAIN- PRIVATE TOUR

Situated below Table Mountain, Devil's Peak and Lion's Head, Cape Town offers a rich cultural and industrial heritage, grand splendour and an assurance of activity and excitement. Including all the 'must-sees' of any Cape Town day tour, this option is a geographical and cultural extravaganza, showing you Cape Town, from its historical beginnings to the dazzling modern city it is today.



Go on an exciting **Abseiling trip** in the best spots of Cape Town. It aims to get the best all-around experience of peace and tranquility combined with unequalled adrenaline. You'll spend the day on the mountain with your instructor and experience what "off the beaten track" really means.



The Private Tour commences with a **Tour of Table Mountain** (Weather permitting: cable car fee is included). Enjoy panoramic views over the Mother City and the Atlantic Seaboard with Robben Island in the distance lying sleepily in Table Bay Harbour. In the city itself, stop at the Company's Garden. Enjoy a walk through the garden and a visit to the South African Museum.

This is followed by a visit to the Castle of Good Hope. Built between 1666 and 1679 by the Dutch East India Company (VOC) as a maritime replenishment station, the Castle of Good Hope is the oldest surviving colonial building in South Africa. The drive through the city centre would also take you past the Houses of Parliament, Grand Parade and City Hall from where Nelson Mandela first addressed South Africans after his release in February 1990.



Have an absolute blast when you go **Tobogganing** at Cool-Runnings!

Cool-Runnings has a 1.25 km long stainless steel sledding track that you can ride using a toboggan (bobsled), which sits one or two people comfortably. A hook pulls you up a slope and then whoosh! Feel the adrenaline rush throughout your body as you ride the winding track. There is a lever that helps you control your speed, so you can go as fast or slow as you want. Think go-carting meets the best slide ever and you have a vague idea of what to expect from tobogganing.



Return to your hotel upon completion of the tour.


DAY 3

FULL DAY CAPE POINT , PENINSULA - PRIVATE TOUR & KAYAKING WITH PENGUINS



This awe-inspiring Private tour to the towering headland known as Cape Point encompasses magnificent beaches, breathtaking views, and picturesque coastal villages. The Cape Peninsula is one of the world's most scenic areas and stretches from the City centre to Cape Point.

Travel along the Atlantic Seaboard via Sea Point, Clifton and Camps Bay, to Hout Bay, a quaint village and fishing harbour with magnificent mountain views and beach. Continue via Chapman's Peak, one of the world's most breathtaking coastal drives, to the Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve and Cape Point which is perceived to be the meeting point of the Atlantic and Indian Oceans.





Go on to historic **Simon's Town**, a village with charming Victorian architecture, a naval base and a large penguin colony at the beautiful Boulder's Beach.

One of the most unique places in the world - a penguin colony in suburban Cape Town! And the best way to see it is from the water. We meet at the town jetty in Simon's Town for a short introduction to paddling technique and a safety briefing.

We then paddle out past the civilian and Naval Harbour where you get a bonus close up view of our biggest naval vessels and out to **Boulders Beach** to see the penguins. On the way we will normally encounter a number of Cape Fur seals. If the time and tide is right we may stop on a beach for a swimming break, or else we swim from the kayaks and get a close up look at penguins on the rocks nearby. Our double kayaks are very stable and perfect for those with no paddling experience and children 10 and up. This is a trip every able bodied individual can and should do.



End the day with a visit to the well-known **Kistenbosch National Botanical Gardens**. The Garden includes five of South Africa's six different biomes and is world-renowned for the beauty and diversity of the Cape Flora it displays as well as for the magnificence of its setting against the eastern slopes of Table Mountain. The tour ends at approx. 17:30 with drop-off at your hotel.

After a fun filled activity at Capetown, you will have a Private road transfer from The Silo to Cape Town Airport for your flight to Singita.




Spanning more than 45,000 acres, Singita Sabi Sand is renowned for high concentrations of big game and frequent leopard sightings.



Cascades & Canyon Spectacular – Helicopter Flight

This exhilarating flight swoops over deep canyons bursting with vegetation and colour. The helicopter lingers above cascading waterfalls, allowing for spectacular photographic opportunities.

Your flight will continue along the escarpment to God's Window which offers awesome panoramic views of the bushveld below and on to the fascinating and dramatic rock formations of the 1 000 metre deep, 30 km long Blyde River Canyon (the third deepest and greenest canyon in the world). You will be treated to a magnificent bird's eye view of the curious Three Rondavels before landing at a picnic site with glorious views of the Mpumalanga Lowveld for a delicious lunch accompanied by South African Sparkling Wine.






30 MINUTE MICROLIGHT


Enjoy a spectacular micro light flight over the mighty **Zambezi River** and impressive **Victoria Falls**. After circling the Falls and islands, we head upstream along the Zambezi River to **Kalai Island**, where we do a low level swoop over the **Mosi-oa-Tunya Zoological Park** for unique game viewing.



After this, your transfer will bring you to **Matetsi Victoria Falls River Lodge** where you will spend 3 nights experiencing a Suite Double Room on a Fully Inclusive with Local Beverages basis. Included are private guide & vehicle, a tour of the falls, canoeing, boats cruises & game drives on the Reserve. 25min Helicopter flight along the river, over the falls & through the gorge.

DAY 9 TO 12 - MATETSI

MATETSI VICTORIA FALLS RIVER LODGE (3 NIGHTS)





Matetsi River lodge is one of the top 10 Safari Lodges in Africa by Travel & Leisure. It is situated on a massive 50 000-hectare private game concession just 40kms from the Victoria Falls - Zimbabwe. 

Victoria Falls

With a guided walking tour of the falls, you will have the opportunity to discover the many facets of the magnificent Victoria Falls. During this exceptional excursion, you can explore the surrounding rainforest in the company of your guide who is intimately acquainted with the history of the Falls, as well as its geological significance, and its flora (plants, if those interest you) and fauna (bird and wildlife, often more interesting for first-timers).



You may also opt to go swimming at the **Devil's Pool**. The Devils Pool itself is a deep natural pool that has been created by thousands of years of erosion, but what is unique about it is that there is a rock ledge on the lip of the Falls, where the water is only a few centimetres deep. This natural barrier is what allows you to jump into the deep pool but not get swept over the edge.



You can now lie on this rock lip at the edge of the Devils Pool and look right into the 103m chasm of the Falls, with huge torrents of water flowing just meters away. The guides will take photos and video of you with your camera if you have one.

The Devils Pool has a real adrenaline high and people who have experienced it Love it!. Once back on Livingstone Island you will be treated to either breakfast, lunch or snacks depending the the time of day you have gone.

Note: When the water level of the Zambezi is too high, the island is completely closed, so neither the "Island Tour" or the "Devils Swim" are open.

DAY12 - HELICOPTER RIDE OVER VICTORIA FALLS WITH LANDING INCLUDING FIRST CLASS PICNIC

What could be more thrilling than flying over the majestic Victoria Falls! Your bird's eye view will give you an exceptional vantage point of the Falls and all the beauty it has to offer.



Enjoy a Helicopter flip, along the river and over the falls. You will then fly back over the Mosi au Tunya National Park and will land at a private picnic spot.

After the picnic, you will fly back to Matetsi.




DAY 13 - JOHANNESBURG AND SOWETO FULL DAY TOUR

During a tour inside you will learn about some of the legal history of Johannesburg. On our way to Newtown we pass by the longest southern African bridge, named Nelson Mandela bridge. At Mary Fitzgerald Square you can walk on the Jazz Walk of Fame. We end this tour with a visit to the Carlton Centre, also known as the ‘Top of Africa’. There a lift will elevate you 50 stories for an amazing and total view over the city. In short, this tour offers you a unique Johannesburg experience at an affordable rate. After collecting you from your hotel or residence in Johannesburg, your guide will give you a quick pre departure tour briefing before departing to Soweto (South Western Township).



DAY 14 - PRETORIA CITY TOUR

On this half day tour, you will learn a lot about the fascinating history of South Africa during a Pretoria city experience. Pretoria is the capital of South Africa and therefore full of historic sites. We visit the Union Buildings, headquarters of the government. The buildings are beautifully situated in terraced gardens, through which you can enjoy an idyllic walk.



Another major attraction on this tour is the Voortrekker Monument. This monument is of great significance to many Afrikaans speaking South Africans because it stands for Afrikaner Nationalism. The monument is in the shape of a big stone cube. The interior walls depict the story of the Great Trek, a mass movement of Afrikaner Boers who resented British rule.



Next interesting site on our tour is the Paul Kruger House Museum. Kruger National Park is named after Paul Kruger. Learn more about this fascinating man and his life. The house displays furniture and personal items of the Kruger family. Pretoria has character in its buildings and during this city architecture tour, you will be given ample opportunity to ask your guide about the history behind the buildings and culture. We visit Church Square with prominent buildings like the Ou Raadsaal, Palace of Justice and Capital Theatre. We can talk for hours about Pretoria, and we will when you are with us! Learn more about Pretoria.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

FLIGHTS:

For flight bookings, we require a copy of all passengers' passports. Airlines require the full names of passengers as printed on the passports and will not accept changes once tickets are issued for security purposes. The company accepts no responsibility for incorrect passport numbers or incorrect spelling of full names. (Any additional charges for changes to flight tickets will be for the clients' account).

Passengers weighing 100kg (220lbs) or more must please notify us in advance as an extra seat must be reserved and costed into the booking. For light aircraft transfers your consultant might request all passenger's weights as part of the booking and confirmation process, this information is required for light aircraft transfer company's, for weight distribution and balancing of aircraft requirements.

In the instance where an airline is grounded for whatever reason (e.g. bad weather), while the company will facilitate the booking of new or alternative transport services, the settlement of such requirements will be for the clients' account. Should the client qualify for any flight refunds the company will facilitate the refund process. Please note airline refunds take between 6-8 weeks in any normal circumstance.

Please note that the luggage allowance on all Southern Africa flights is 20 kg (44lbs) per person. In addition to this, luggage needs to be soft sided (no wheels or rigid frames for Botswana or East Africa) for scheduled charter flights and cannot be overly large or bulky. The allowance for scheduled charter flights in East Africa is 15 kg (33lbs).

Minimum connecting times

We request that you advise us of your exact International arrival/departure dates and times and to ensure that the minimum connecting times are adhered to.

Between International & International flight - 1 ½ to 2 hours

Between International & Domestic flight (in either direction) - 1 ½ hours

Between Domestic & Domestic flight - 1 hour

We strongly recommend allowing for an additional 30 minutes onto these times to ensure a smooth and stress-free transit.

Involuntary schedule changes, technical stops en-route & Force Majeure It is important to take special note that all IATA airlines have the right to change the times and routings of their scheduled flights, including voluntary technical stops en-route (i.e. re-fuelling) without prior notice and are protected by the Warsaw Convention from any legal liability in doing so.

Therefore, in the unlikely event of involuntary schedule changes, technical stops en-route and/or force majeure, we and our partner endeavour to keep any inconvenience to a minimum. It is understood though that any circumstances beyond our control which relate to unscheduled extensions will be for the Client's account.

Please note that we will always quote and confirm on best available economy fare seats. Many domestic and regional flights do not offer a Business or First Class service. Where Business Class is available, there is not much of difference compared to economy class due to the size of the aircraft and the comparatively short distances between destinations. Should you wish to obtain an option for business class seats, please let your consultant know.

Payment Terms:

On presentation of an invoice, we require full pre-payment for international, domestic and regional flights (excluding chartered flights) and 30% deposit on the difference in order to confirm your travel arrangements. (Subject to certain of our suppliers' payment policies being more stringent than ours for bookings during their peak season or specials).

The balance of payment is due 12 weeks (90 days) prior to travel.

Bookings made within 12 weeks (90 days) prior to travel will be subject to full prepayment on presentation of invoice.

Standard Cancellation Policy

Cancellation prior to 12 weeks of travel - Full 30% deposit is forfeited

Cancellation 12-8 weeks prior to travel - 50% of total cost is forfeited

Cancellation less than 8 weeks prior to travel - 100% of total cost is forfeited

Please note that at certain times of the year and for certain of our suppliers, cancellation policies may be more stringent than our above policy and therefore the Company holds the right to forward such additional cancellation charges onto the client should such an instance occur.

Financial Protection (Included)

Medical insurance & cancellation / curtailment cover (NOT Included)

Sufficient insurance cover is absolutely essential during your holiday. Most importantly, cover against cancellation fees should be considered a must, as you need to be protected against financial loss should you or your family members not be able to travel due to medical reasons.

Yellow Fever

Certain African countries require proof of vaccination against Yellow Fever. The requirements differ depending on your destination, which country you have travelled from and which countries were previously visited.

Passengers traveling to / from / through the following countries will need proof of yellow fever vaccination:

Angola, Argentina, Benin, Bolivia, Brazil, Burkina Faso, Burundi, Cameroon, Central African Republic, Chad, Colombia, Congo, Ivory Coast, Democratic Republic of the Congo, Ecuador, Equatorial Guinea, Ethiopia, Guyana, Gabon, Gambia, Ghana, Guinea, Guinea-Bissau, Guyana, Kenya, Liberia, Mali, Mauritania, Niger, Nigeria, Panama, Paraguay, Peru, Rwanda, Sao Tome and Principe, Senegal, Sierra Leone, Somalia, Sudan, Suriname, Togo, Trinidad and Tobago, Uganda, Venezuela.

It is imperative that you clarify the requirements for your particular journey before travel. Please consult the relevant embassy of your intended destination. Travellers will be denied entry to several countries without a certificate of vaccination. The vaccination must be given at a designated clinic and it is valid for 10 years. The vaccination MUST be done no less than 10 days prior to travel. The vaccination is live and should not be given to immunocompromised or pregnant travellers. There is no specific treatment for yellow fever although rest, drugs can be given to lower temperature, relieve vomiting and pain, coupled with rehydration therapy.

Due to frequently the changing requirements, Rhino Africa Safaris can only give advice, and will not be held responsible for costs incurred if entry requirements and vaccination requirements are not met.

Passports and Children

Please note that your passport must have two consecutive side by side blank visa pages (i.e. a left and a right hand page) per country that is visited. Should your passport not comply with these requirements, you will either not be permitted to board the aircraft or risk deportation on arrival at your destination. Parents travelling with children (any person under 18 years of age at time of travel) into or out of South Africa may be asked to show the child's full unabridged birth certificate. A parent traveling with children, without the other parent, will need a police certified letter of consent from the absent parent. Furthermore, please note that passengers entering many African Countries (including but not limited to South Africa, Botswana and Zambia) must have passports valid for at least 6 months after the travel entry date. Failure to adhere to this regulation may result in immediate deportation to the country of origin at own cost to the client.

Liability

All tours are booked and arrangements are made, on the express condition that the Company, its employees and agents, shall not be responsible for, and shall be exempt from, all liability in respect of loss, damage, accident, injury, death, delay or inconvenience to any Client (which shall be deemed to include the heirs, executors, administrators or assigns of the Client), their luggage, or other property, wherever, whenever and however the same may occur. The Client indemnifies and holds harmless the Company, its employees and agents accordingly. The Company, its employees and agents shall furthermore not be liable for any consequential loss or damages whatsoever.

The Company provide Clients with travel and/or other services either itself or acting as agents for suppliers engaged in or associated with the travel industry, such as hotels, car hire companies, transfer companies, airlines etc. The Company accepts no liability for any loss, damage, injury or death which any Client may suffer as a result of any alteration, act or omission on the part of or the failure of such suppliers to fulfill their obligations, whether in relation to travel arrangements, accommodation or otherwise. The contract in use by such suppliers shall constitute the sole contract between the supplier and the Client and any right of recourse the Client may have, will be solely against such supplier.
