## DAY 1 ARRIVE LISB ON, PORTUGAL

Arrive in Lisbon, where you are met and transferred to your hotel in the city center. Tonight, join your Resident Tour Director and fellow guests for a welcome reception and dinner.

## DAY 2 LISB ON | PRIVATE DINNER WITH FADO PERFORM ANCE

Begin your day with a visit to the National Coach Museum to see ceremonial and promenade vehicles from the 17th to 19th centuries. Proceed to the Jeronimos Monastery to admire its Manueline-style architecture, and then explore the Calouste Gulbenkian Museum. Tonight, experience the magic of Portugal's ancient Fado tradition over dinner.

## DAY 3 SINTRA | ROM ANTIC CASTLES B Y THE SEA

Travel just outside Lisbon today to Sintra, designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site for its stunning 19th-century monuments. Explore the National Palace of Portugal, the best-preserved medieval royal residence in the country, and then proceed to the Pena Palace, decorated with vivid colors and evocative stone carvings. Return to Lisbon for time at leisure.

## DAY 4 B ARCELONA, SPAIN | A CITY RICH IN HISTORY

Leave Lisbon for nearby Setubal for a private exploration of one of Portugal's oldest wineries. After lunch, drive to Beja, and then fly by private charter aircraft to sunny Barcelona. Take in the views from the hill of Montjuïc, and then ride the cable car to the port and savor dinner beside the sea, before checking in to your hotel.

## DAY 5 B ARCELONA | GAUDÍ'S M AGNIFICENT WONDER

View the Barcelona Pavilion, and then discover the Sagrada Família, a spectacular basilica designed by Catalan architect Antoni Gaudí. Enjoy your afternoon at leisure, perhaps stopping for lunch in the Central Market, also known as La Boqueria, free to explore the city. Tonight, gather for a flavorful tapas experience and a flamenco performance.

## DAY 6 FIGUERES | B IRTHPPLACE OF SALVADOR DALÍ

Travel overland to Figueres, where you are guided through the Salvador Dalí Theater-Museum, designed by Dalí himself and considered the world's largest surrealist object. Continue to Girona, a city that boasts Romanesque towers, medieval stone ramparts and a cathedral with the widest Gothic nave in the world. Explore the charming old Jewish Quarter and visit the medieval Arab baths before returning to Barcelona.

## DAY 7 M ONACO | LIFE ON THE CÔTE D'AZUR

This morning, your privately chartered aircraft whisks you to Nice, where you visit St. Paul de Vence, a village perched high above the sea that was once home to artist Marc Chagall. Walk its narrow streets, eat lunch as you soak in the views and play a friendly game of petanque with the locals. Proceed to Monte Carlo in Monaco, arriving at your hotel, located just steps from the storied casino. Tonight, gain exclusive private entry to the Prince's Palace, followed by dinner. ## DAY 8 M ONACO | CHARM S OF THE FRENCH RIVIERA

Delight in a scenic drive with breathtaking views en route to the delightful villages of Eze and Beaulieu-sur-Mer. Next, explore the marvelous gardens of the Rothschild's Villa Ephrussi. Then, privately visit an olive farm for a tasting of the oil pressed there, and meet the owner, a noted author.

## DAY 9 NAPLES, ITALY/SORRENTO | A GLIM PSE INTO HISTORY

Afterward, visit the National Archaeological Museum to view many of the treasures excavated from Pompeii and Herculaneum. Later, travel to the coastal town of Sorrento and settle into your hotel.

## DAY 10 AM ALFI COAST | A LESSON IN THE LOCAL CUISINE

Later, descend to Amalfi itself and return to Sorrento by boat on a cruise along the scenic coast.

## DAY 11 POM PEII & DUB ROVNIK, CROATIA | ACROSS THE ADRIATIC

Then, fly to Dubrovnik by privately chartered aircraft, where you ride a cable car up Mount Srd for a Scenic Sundowner with stunning views over the sea. Return to Dubrovnik for dinner.
